Marblehead Cowl

Designed by Kate Dailey

A Broken Rib Cowl, which reflects the rocky coastline of New England.

The Cowl will be about 46" around and 10-12" deep

Gauge is flexible: 3.5-4 sts per inch in broken rib pattern. It should be loose and cozy.

Materials 250-300 yards of Bulky Yarn #10 32" Needle

Instructions

Cast on 180 Stitches

Join in the round being careful not to twist

Place Marker at the beginning of the round

Row 1 : (Knit 1 Purl 1) repeat around

Row 2: Knit

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until desired width, leaving enough yarn to cast off.

Cast off all stitches and weave in ends.

Enjoy!
